First Aid Information:

Product Concentrated

Eye contact	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists obtain medical attention. Get medical attention.
Skin contact	Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by a warm water rinse.
If inhaled	Allow person to breath fresh air. Allow person to rest.
If swallowed	Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.
