



First Aid Information:	Eye contact	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists obtain medical attention. Get medical attention.
Product Concentrated	Skin contact	Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by a warm water rinse.
	If inhaled	Allow person to breath fresh air. Allow person to rest.
	If swallowed	Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.
Firefighting measures:	Water spray. Dry powder. Foam. Carbon dioxide.	
Special requirements:	Store in the original container in a cool, well ventilated place away from bases.	

## **Accidental Release Measures**

- If an accidental release occurs ensure people and colleagues are moved away.
- Ensure the spill is dealt with by trained colleagues (i.e. know how to deal with spills and how to use spill kits) and wear appropriate PPE.
- Follow the Immediate Spill Response Plan contained within the Environment Toolkit and the Unit Managers Emergency Manual.
