Procedure - Dispensing of product via dosing unit into spray bottle	
Surface Sanitising	Fill correctly labelled spray bottle with 600ml of clean water. Add 2x pump (10ml) to trigger spray.
Manual Pot & Pan Cleaning	Fill the sink to the required level of water. Add 4x pumps (40ml) to 10 litres of water
