## Pallet gates - manual sliding

## Safe System of Work

- 1. Only use the pallet gate if you have been trained to do so.
- 2. No other staff are permitted in the loading areas while the gate is in use.
- 3. Make sure the platform around the gate is completely clear before opening or closing the gate.
- 4. When opening and closing the gate you must at all times remain away from the exposed edge and behind the barrier.
- 5. Take extreme care when opening/closing the gate and remain focussed on the task.
- 6. Access to the loading area is not permitted while loading/unloading is in progress.
- 7. Keep hands away from moving parts when opening or closing the gate to avoid entrapment.
- 8. Care must be taken to ensure the load is fully positioned on the platform and does not overhang.
- 9. When not in use the gate must always be in the closed position, with a safety catch or lock in place.
- 10. Follow safe manual handling practices when unloading or loading the platform.
