### Safe System of Work

- Wherever practicable, ensure that work tasks are rotated to avoid long periods of repetitive work activity. 1.
- 2. Keep clothing and oven cloths out of reach of rotating parts to prevent them from becoming entangled.
- 3. Dispose of any broken glass and crockery by putting it in the designated broken glass and crockery bin or wrap it securely in cardboard before placing it in general waste.
- Clean up spillages as they occur and use wet floor warning signs when appropriate. 4.

Back, upper arm and neck pains due to repetitive movements



Slip injuries from spillages



Cuts/lacerations from broken glass and crockery

Crush injuries. bruises.
