

Peanut and Tree Nut Policy

It is Levy UK and Ireland's policy that tree nuts and peanuts, and products that contain tree nuts or peanuts are not purchased, stored or served in our units. This includes where external chefs are contracted to operate areas. There are some exemptions that permit products that contain tree nuts or peanuts to be used and served:

- Tree nut and peanut containing foods may be stored and served in certain areas at the request of the client (*which must be in writing*). This includes training grounds, sports team areas and similar facilities, where there may be a requirement to provide products such as peanut butter, nut bars etc.
- Items that are purchased packaged and served packaged, remaining in their packaging from delivery until service, such as individually packed cereal bars, chocolate bars, ice creams etc. Consideration should be given to the type of product, and loose tree nut or peanut products, such as bags of peanuts, should be avoided.
- Concessionaires must be aware of this policy and not handle tree nuts and peanuts in their units such as chopped peanuts or nut powders. However, they are permitted to sell products that are bought in and contain nuts, such as cakes, slices, ice creams, chocolate spread (e.g. Nutella). Baked goods that are topped with any type of tree nut or peanut must be sold in their packaging or they are not permitted.

This policy has been agreed by the Levy UK&I Director of Culinary and the Director of HSE and signed accordingly. This policy is deemed current until amended or updated.
