

Stage 3	Re-apply D10 and leave in contact with surface for 5 minutes
Stage 4	Rinse with clean water and allow to air dry
Stage 5	Rinse with clean water and air dry

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Product Concentrated AS SOLD	At Use Dilution
Remove from source of exposure	
Remove product from mouth, give the casualty a small quantity of water to drink and seek medical advice. Do not induce vomiting.

Rinse immediately with plenty of water, holding the eyelids open and seek medical advice if effects persist.
