Procedure – sanitising surfaces	
Stage 1	Pull wipe from container
Stage 2	Wipe surface, air dry for 30 seconds
Stage 3	Dispose of wipe

First Aid Information:

Eye contact	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
Skin contact	Take off all contaminated clothing immediately and wash before reuse.
If inhaled	Get medical advice if you feel unwell.
If swallowed	Rinse mouth. Immediately drink 1 glass of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell.
